Questions as a Catalyst for Further Discussions

- What are ways you have or can “demand a change for children?”
- What are ways you have or can inspire a change of heart to help make the sexual abuse and exploitation of children less likely?
- What do you know about how to help end the sexual abuse and exploitation of children?
 - What in the culture/environment makes children more/less vulnerable?
 - What in the culture/environment makes it easier/harder for someone to perpetrate?
 - Given most perpetrators are males, and most often are known and trusted to those they victimize, what are the best ways to help reduce the risk of perpetrating?
 - What needs to happen so fewer people are willing, able, or interested in perpetrating?
 - What can you do to help end the sexual abuse of children?
- What makes it easier/harder for bystanders to do the right thing when they see or suspect sexually harmful behavior?
- What makes it easier/harder for people to listen to, help, or support a victim?
- How does your life experience help you be a voice for children?
- How are you, or how can you be, part of the solution?
- What classes/supports are needed to help grow a generation of prevention activists who work for social change and social justice?
